## THE RESOLUTION

Noting that 16 U.S. intelligence agencies have agreed that Iran does not have a nuclear weapons program and that it poses no imminent threat to the US, the resolution expresses the will of the people of Chicago opposing any US attack on Iran and urging the Bush Administration to engage Iran diplomatically.

This resolution was introduced in City Council by Alderman Joe Moore and has over 10 cosponsors.
